I felt compelled to address a subject that a lot of people struggle with – especially women. – JELOUSY!

Stop for a moment & just think how many times you have felt Jealous & envious towards someone. Think about how much that jealousy hindered prayers and intimacy with God, it's such a destructive attitude that poisons the way you view life.
